poverty guidelines. HWAP providers give priority to people over the age of 60 and those

with disabilities.

Eligible Repairs: Safety inspection, tune-up/repair and if necessary, installation of heating units; insulation

of attics, sidewalls, heating ducts, floors, water tanks; reduction of air leakage from major

sources; personalized energy management plans

Type of Funding: Grant of direct service. No cash benefits.

Name of Program: Very Low Income Housing Repair Program

Agency: USDA Rural Development

Description: Provides loans and grants to very low-income homeowners to repair, improve, or modernize

their home. COUNTY ONLY PARTIALLY ELIGIBLE.

Eligibility: Loans

To obtain a loan, homeowner-occupants must be unable to obtain affordable credit

elsewhere and must have very low incomes, defined as below 50 percent of the area

median income. Loans are at 1 percent interest with up to 20 years to repay.

Eligibility: Grants Grants are only available to homeowners who are 62 years old or older and cannot repay

a Section 504 Loan.

Eligible Repairs: Funds may only be used for repairs or improvements to remove health and safety hazards,

or to complete repairs to make the dwelling accessible for household members with

disabilities.

Lancaster Homeowner Emergency Repair Assistance

Agency: City of Lancaster, Community Development Department

Description: The City of Lancaster's Community Development Department (CDBG) Homeowner

Emergency Home Repair Program offers financial assistance in the form of a grant up to

\$5,000. The assistance may provide low and moderate income, owner-occupied

households with eligible minor home repairs which are an imminent threat to the health and

safety of the occupants.

Eligibility:Be the owner and occupant of a single family dwelling unit within the incorporated area of

the city of Lancaster. Be current on both mortgage and property tax payments. The household may not have more than \$5,000 in cash assets at the time of the application. An on-site inspection by the CDBG Housing Program Coordinator will be required to determine the work scope of the minor home repair project. Homeowners must also meet

income guidelines.

Eligible Repairs: Eligible repairs may include roofing, electrical, plumbing, heating/cooling, flooring, and

other repairs that will correct minor existing hazardous living conditions in non-painted areas. The eligible repairs can not exceed the maximum grant amount. No repayment is

required.

Type of Funding: Grant up to \$5,000.
